

ALPA Sync Release Mk II - Illustration of use

ALPA Sync Release Mk II, mounted with golden ALPA release trigger

Please note:

When mounted correctly, the wake-up trigger is performed within the first 1-2 millimeter of travel. Therefore: If triggered inadvertently/without releasing the shutter (and taking a picture) a two shot error is reported by the back when the latency time has elapsed. Normal latency of Phase One backs is some 2-3 seconds, e.g. If so, just confirm the error message of the back.

It is recommended to plug in the Sync Release cabling after mounting the Sync Release box. Removing the Sync Release can trigger the wake-up.



Mount the Sync Release box with the new ALPA trigger. It is not working with the older version of the trigger. Every Sync Release will be delivered with such a new gilded trigger.





The box can get mounted with the socket for the cable release instead.





The device not in use (either the trigger or the cable release socket as shown in this picture) can be screwed in/stored underneath.





The ALPA Sync Release Mk II trigger is delivered with the box, the gilded (14k) trigger and cable release socket. The complete product is Swiss Made, including the socket for the LEMO plugs for the LEMO plugs used with the ALPA Sync Release cabling.
